8. PROCEDURES FOLLOWING REMAND BY APPELLATE COURT [LBR 8020-1]:

Local Bankruptcy Rule 8020-1 states: Whenever a case, proceeding or matter is remanded by an Appellate Court to the Bankruptcy Court for further proceedings, any party to the appeal may move to set the matter for further proceedings by filing a motion pursuant to LBR 9014-1. The Court will not set the matter for further proceedings as a matter of course.

9. APPEALS TO THE NINTH CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS:

An appeal to the Ninth Circuit will be filed with BAP or DC depending where the original appeal was heard. The appeal must be filed within 30 days after the decision has been made (60 days for U.S.A.)

Either BAP or DC will forward the Ninth Circuit mandate to us once they receive it.
