**GENERAL ORDER NO. 13-02**

In the event that an appropriation bill or continuing resolution funding the operation of the United States Courts is not passed prior to the current funding expiring, this Order shall take effect and without further notice.

The dispensing of justice is an essential part of the functioning of our federal government. Accordingly, all employees in the judges' chambers and clerk's office are deemed essential and hereby declared as such.

All court employees described in the preceding paragraph are ordered to report for work according to their regularly scheduled hours and shall continue all normal operations.
