25 The court has reviewed the Complaint for Declaratory and
26 Injunctive Relief and Application for a Temporary Restraining
27 Order and Preliminary Injunction.

28 The Complaint and supporting papers are conspicuous by the
omission of any reference to, or discussion of, 11 U.S.C. § 904:

1 **§ 904. Limitation on jurisdiction and powers of court**

2 Notwithstanding any power of the court,
3 unless the debtor consents or the plan so
4 provides, the court may not, by any stay, order,
5 or decree, in the case or otherwise, interfere
6 with –

7 (1) any of the political or governmental
8 powers of the debtor;

9 (2) any of the property or revenues of the
10 debtor; or

11 (3) the debtor's use or enjoyment of any
12 income-producing property.

13 11 U.S.C. § 904.

14 IT IS ORDERED that the Plaintiffs shall file a brief by
15 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 18, 2012, explaining why any of the
16 relief sought in the complaint can be awarded, without the
17 consent of the debtor, in light of 11 U.S.C. § 904. Such brief
18 shall be served on counsel for the Defendant and debtor in the
19 parent chapter 9 case by electronic means at the time the brief
20 is filed.

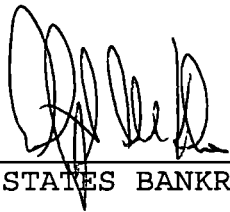
21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant may file a responsive
22 brief by 4:00 p.m., Friday, July 20, 2012, which brief shall be
