Before You Title That Pleading

The Eastern District Bankruptcy Court strives for complete accuracy when docketing your pleadings. To assist us in docketing your pleadings, a list of commonly filed pleadings was created for your reference. The list below was not created to discourage filers from including all major requests for relief. Instead, the list is meant to eliminate unnecessary language from the title of the document. Further, following this list assists the court in docketing your documents more quickly and accurately than before. Should you have any questions or concerns regarding the list, please contact the Operations Coordinator or Division Manager in the appropriate divisional office.

- Motion for Compensation by (*name of filer*) as (*capacity*)
- Motion to Employ (name) as (type, i.e., *attorney or accountant*)
- Motion to Employ (name) as (type, i.e., *auctioneer or broker*) and Motion to Sell [*if applicable*]
- Motion to Employ (name) as (type, i.e., *auctioneer, broker or accountant*) and Request for Approval of Flat Fee/Commission [*if applicable*]
- Motion to Sell (*Personal or Real*) Property
- Motion for Authority to Use Cash Collateral
- Motion to Avoid Lien
- Motion to Compromise Controversy Between Trustee and (*creditor name*)
- Motion to Dismiss Case
- Motion to Value Collateral
- Amended Plan
- Objection to Claim of (*creditor name*), Claim #__
- Objection to Confirmation of Plan
- Objection to Confirmation of Plan and To Dismiss Case [*if applicable*]
