The motion will be denied for the following reasons: (1) the moving parties gave only 38 days' notice of the hearing rather than 42 days', as required by LBR 3015-1(d)(1) and applicable rules; and (2) the moving parties served the motion, notice of hearing, plan, supporting memorandum, and declaration on the United States Trustee, the chapter 13 trustee, secured creditors, and the party requesting special notice, but served only the plan and notice of hearing on all other creditors, whereas the rule provides "the debtor shall file and serve the modified chapter 13 plan together with a motion to confirm it." LBR 3015-1(d)(1).

As a result of these notice defects, the motion will be denied by minute order. No appearance is necessary.
