NOTICE TO THE BAR AND PUBLIC CONCERNING STATUTORY FEE CHANGES

September 1, 2005

Effective October 17, 2005, the fees required by 28 U.S.C §1930 to commence cases under chapter 7, chapter 11, and chapter 13 of the bankruptcy code will change, as follows:

Chapter 7: The fees due upon the filing of a chapter 7 petition will **increase** from \$209.00 to **\$274.00**.

Chapter 11: The fees due upon the filing of a chapter 11 petition will **increase** from \$839.00 to **\$1,039.00**.

Chapter 13: The fees due upon the filing of a chapter 13 petition will **decrease** from \$194.00 to **\$189.00**.

Fees for filing motions to reopen cases under these chapters, as well as the fees for splitting joint cases filed under these chapters, will also change effective October 17, 2005. For additional information, please see <u>Fees Commonly Charged by the Bankruptcy Court</u>, Form EDC 2-033.
