NOTICE REGARDING CREDIT REPORTING

Please be advised that the filing of bankruptcy is a public record. Information about your bankruptcy filing, including some information in the documents you file, are routinely collected by credit reporting companies.

The court has no jurisdiction over credit reporting companies and cannot intervene to strike or remove records on your behalf. Therefore, disputes that you may have about information that a credit reporting company makes available to the public must be handled directly with that company. You may wish to investigate the information contained within the *Fair Credit Reporting Act*, 6 U.S.C., Section 605, which is the law that governs credit reporting companies, or you may consider contacting the Bureau of Consumer Protection as shown below.
