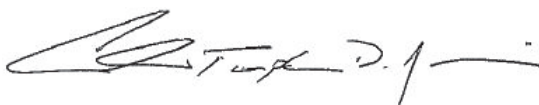
WHEREAS, upon the retirement of the Honorable Fredrick E. Clement in March 2026, the Sacramento Division of the Eastern District of California Bankruptcy Court will have one active bankruptcy judge and one recalled bankruptcy judge, with the appointment of two new bankruptcy judges pending. Therefore, good cause appearing:

IT IS ORDERED that new cases and adversary proceedings filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of California from Stanislaus, Tuolumne, and Calaveras counties on or after January 2, 2026, will be assigned to the Fresno Division.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that these cases and adversary proceedings will remain in the Fresno Division for their entire lifespan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that assignment of cases and adversary proceedings from Stanislaus, Tuolumne, and Calaveras counties will resume as prescribed in Local Bankruptcy Rule 1002-1 after bankruptcy judges appointed to fill the two vacancies in the Sacramento Division of the Eastern District of California Bankruptcy Court are sworn in as active bankruptcy judges.
