IV. FILING YOUR COMPLETED FORMS

Bankruptcy petitions, pleadings, and other papers may be submitted for filing by mail or in person at the Clerk's Office public counters. All three Eastern District of California Bankruptcy Clerk's Offices are open from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. on all days except Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays. The addresses and public telephone numbers for each divisional office are indicated below.

After completing and assembling the original and copies of your bankruptcy papers, mail or deliver them to the appropriate divisional Clerk's Office with your filing fee payment, completed application to pay fees in installments or completed application for waiver of chapter 7 fees. The Clerk's Office will "FILED" stamp and return the copy of your bankruptcy papers to you. If you mail your papers, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope of sufficient size for return of your "FILED" stamped copy by mail.
