## Local Rule 2016-4 Deadline to File Disclosure of Compensation in Chapter 7 and Chapter 13 Cases

In a chapter 7 or chapter 13 case, the debtor must file the Disclosure of Compensation of Attorney for the Debtor, Form B2030, with the petition, rather than 14 days thereafter. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016(b). If the debtor fails to file the Disclosure of Compensation of the Attorney for the Debtor with the petition, the Clerk of the Court shall issue an order setting the matter for hearing before the judge to whom the case is then assigned.
