This memorandum decision is not approved for publication and may not be cited except when relevant under the doctrine of law of the case or the rules of claim preclusion or issue preclusion.

Idowu Oghogho (the "debtor") filed a Chapter 11 petition in pro se on September 20, 2007. At the debtor's request, the case was converted to Chapter 7 on February 13, 2008. On February 20, 2008 the debtor filed an Amended Schedule of Real Property (Schedule A), and an Amended Schedule of Secured Debt (Schedule D) (the "Amended Schedules").

The Amended Schedules list the debtor's interest in the real property commonly referred to as 2312 52nd Street, Sacramento, California (the "Property"), and values the Property at \$220,000. The Amended Schedules list Downey Savings & Loan with a senior secured claim on the Property in the amount of \$305,000. Amended Schedules also list Bank of America with a junior secured claim on the Property in excess of \$19,000.

On March 6, 2008 Bank of America filed a motion for relief from stay and the motion came on for hearing at the time and date indicated above. Based on the debtor's Amended Schedules, there is no equity in the Property. The debtor is not making payments to either Downey Savings & Loan or the Bank of America.

Accordingly, the court finds that Bank of America's interest in the Property is not adequately protected and relief from stay under section 362(b)(d)(1) is appropriate. In addition, as this is a Chapter 7 liquidation, the Property is not necessary for an effective reorganization. Accordingly, relief from stay is also warranted pursuant to section 362(d)(2).

For the reasons set forth in this memorandum the court will issue an order granting Bank of America relief from stay.
