The court's decision is to not confirm the first amended plan.

Debtor's plan does not meet the liquidation test of 11 U.S.C. § 1325(a)(4). Based on a review of Debtors' schedules, Debtors have non-exempt assets of \$107,090.35 available for distribution to general unsecured creditors. Debtors' non-priority general unsecured claims total \$268,278.93. Therefore, Debtors' plan must pay 40% to general unsecured creditors. Because their plan pays 0%, it fails the liquidation test.

The amended plan does not comply with 11 U.S.C. \$\$ 1322, 1323, and 1325(a) and is not confirmed.
