MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY 6-24-14 [51]

FIRST NORTHERN BANK OF DIXON VS.

**Tentative Ruling:** This is a properly filed motion under LBR 9014-1(f)(2). Opposition may be presented at the hearing. In this instance, because the debtors' amended plan proposes to surrender the Property (as that term is defined herein) to the movant, the court issues the following tentative ruling.

The motion is granted in part. The automatic stay is modified as to the debtor and the estate pursuant to 11 U.S.C. \$ 362(d)(1) and (d)(2) in order to permit the movant to foreclose on the real property located at 10 N. East Street #104, Woodland, California (APN 63-102-71)(the "Property") and to obtain possession of the Property following the sale, all in accordance with applicable non-bankruptcy law. The 14-day period specified in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 4001(a)(3) is waived. Except as so ordered, the motion is denied.

The debtors' first amended plan, which the court has confirmed without oral argument elsewhere on this morning's calendars, proposes to treat the movant's claim as a class 3 claim satisfied by the surrender of the Property and does not propose to make any payment to the movant. The movant alleges without dispute that the debtors have failed to make four post-petition mortgage payments. Movant further alleges without dispute that there is no equity in the Property and the Property is not necessary to an effective reorganization or rehabilitation in this chapter 13 case where the debtors propose to surrender it to the movant pursuant to the terms of their plan.

The court will issue a minute order.
