#### Final Ruling

The motion has been set for hearing on 28-days notice. Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1(f)(1). The failure of the respondent and other parties in interest to file written opposition at least 14 days prior to the hearing as required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1(f)(1)(B) is considered to be the equivalent of a statement of nonopposition. *Cf. Ghazali v. Moran*, 46 F.3d 52, 53 (9th Cir. 1995). No opposition was filed. The matter will be resolved without oral argument. No appearance at the hearing is required.

The court's decision is to deny without prejudice the motion to dismiss case.

The Chapter 13 Trustee ("Trustee") moves to dismiss the case on grounds that the Debtors have caused unreasonable delay that is prejudicial to creditors since Debtors have failed to set a hearing for an amended plan, failed to file a complete plan, failed to make plan payments, and failed to accurately file Schedule E/F.

The Debtors filed a second amended plan with a confirmation hearing set for October 15, 2024. Debtors also filed amended schedules on September 11, 2024. Therefore, the issues raised by the Trustee are resolved.

Cause does not exist to dismiss this case. The motion is denied and the case will not be dismissed.

The motion is ORDERED DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE for reasons stated in the minutes.
