

# Final ruling:

This is the debtor's motion to confirm a modified chapter 13 plan. The motion will be denied for the following reasons. First, an earlier motion was denied because the debtor had filed two different plans in the case, both entitled "Chapter 13 Plan," making it impossible to determine from the proof of service which of the plans was served. This time, the plan is entitled "Amended Chapter 13 Plan" but the proof of service refers only to a "Chapter 13 Plan." Thus, again, there is insufficient evidence as to which of the three plans filed in this case was served. Second, as with the earlier motion, the proof of service does not sufficiently evidence the manner of service in that it does not state that the documents were placed in envelopes or that the envelopes were mailed with postage fully prepaid. Third, as with the earlier motion, the moving party failed to serve the creditors filing Claim Nos. 1 and 4 through 8 at the addresses on their proofs of claim, as required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(g).

For the reasons stated, the motion will be denied and the court need not reach the issues raised by the trustee at this time. The motion will be denied by minute order. No appearance is necessary.
