**PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES
GOVERNING VIDEO AND TELEPHONIC APPEARANCES VIA ZOOM**

Parties in interest and members of the general public may appear by video, free of charge, using Zoom before the Honorable Christopher M. Klein.

All parties appearing by Zoom.Gov are required to comply with the following guidelines and procedures:

2. Participants and members of the public should at all times remember that although conducted remotely, these hearings are official court proceedings; and individuals should act accordingly.
 - a. Proper dress and decorum are required.
 - b. To safeguard your privacy, the use of virtual backgrounds is permitted. If you choose to use a virtual background, please ensure it is both appropriate and professional.

4. Zoom participants shall specify their display name. Please include the full name of each party appearing on each device.
5. Cameras are to remain on for all participants appearing unless otherwise instructed by the court.
6. Listen-only participants are to turn off their camera, remain on mute, and type "Listen Only" before their name.
7. In order to avoid parties speaking simultaneously, please wait until the judge calls on you before making your appearance.
8. When making an appearance, please state your name, whether or not you are an attorney, and if so, whom you represent.
