**NOTICE RE HEARING DATES AND TIMES
APRIL, MAY AND JUNE 2026**

Below is a list of dates through June 30, 2026, for hearings on law and motion matters as well as hearings to approve disclosure statements and to confirm plans. The dates listed below must be used by the moving party to “self-set” hearings with the notice required by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Local Bankruptcy Rules 3007-1 and 9014-1.

Cases and proceedings are assigned to either Department B by Judge Christopher D. Jaime or to Department C by Judge Christopher M. Klein.

The Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 contains several provisions requiring or permitting an expedited hearing. See, *inter alia*, 11 U.S.C. " 362(c)(3); 362(c)(4); 362(h)(2); 361(1)(2); 362(m); 521(a)(2)(A); 521(a)(6); 521(i)(4); 727(a)(12); 1112(b)(3); 1116(3); 1228(f); 1328(h). All motions requiring an expedited hearing, whether, related to the new bankruptcy law, shall be set for hearing before the assigned judge on the notice required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1(f)(1) [28 days’ notice of the hearing] or (f)(2) [14 days’ notice of the hearing]. The moving party must serve all persons entitled to notice with the motion and the notice of the hearing. When an expedited hearing is necessary but there is no available hearing date or no hearing date that permits giving the amount of notice required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1(f)(1) or (f)(2), or when emergency circumstances warrant a more immediate hearing, the party making the motion shall request in writing that the amount of notice be shortened [see Local Bankruptcy Rule 9014-1(f)(3)] and/or that the motion be specially set for hearing. It is the responsibility of the party making the motion to ensure that it is filed and served timely and set for hearing within the time constraints imposed by the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, and the circumstances of the case.

Tentative rulings, dispositions without oral argument, matters resolved without oral argument, and matters continued for evidentiary hearings are posted prior to the scheduled hearing on the Court’s Internet site, www.caeb.uscourts.gov . To view the “Pre-hearing Dispositions” select Calendar Info on the Court’s home page and then click the “Pre-hearing Disposition” button. Parties appearing by telephone or by zoom must review all pre-hearing dispositions before the hearing. Failure to do so may result in the imposition of sanctions, including taking the matter as submitted without oral argument or continuing the hearing.

Hearings on reaffirmation agreements, as well as status and pretrial conferences in adversary proceedings, are set by the Clerk’s Office. For informational purposes only, the last page of this notice gives the dates each Department will consider these matters.
