Amended General Order No. 24-04

Effective March 1, 2025, the position of the Clerk of the Court for the Bankruptcy Court and for the Eastern District of California will be vacant. The judges of the Bankruptcy Court in and for the Eastern District of California are presently engaged in a nationwide search for a well-qualified person to fill that position. 28 U.S.C. § 156(b).

An ad hoc committee is hereby formed to assist the court in the selection of the most qualified person for the Clerk of the Court position. Hagop Bedoyan shall be the chairperson of the committee. The committee will consist of the following eight persons: Hagop Bedoyan, attorney, Fresno; Megan Dunning, Team Leader, Bankruptcy Court Eastern District of California, Sacramento; Lilian Tsang, Chapter 13 trustee, Modesto; Teri Wegemer, paralegal for Chapter 13 trustee David Cusick, Sacramento; Walter Dahl, attorney and Subchapter V trustee, Granite Bay; Mark Zimmerman, attorney, Hanford; Loris Bakken, Chapter 7 trustee, Lodi; and Pauldeep Bains, attorney,

1 Roseville.

2 For each applicant selected for an interview by the collective  
3 bankruptcy court bench, the committee shall: (1) conduct an  
4 interview to ascertain his/her qualifications, as well as to assess  
5 his/her relative strengths vis-à-vis each other applicant for the  
6 position; and (2) reduce its findings to writing and submit them to  
7 the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court.
