Effective March 1, 2025, the position of the Clerk of the Court for the Bankruptcy Court and for the Eastern District of California will be vacant. The committee will consist of the following nine persons: Hagop Bedoyan, attorney, Fresno; Megan Dunning, Team Leader, Bankruptcy Court Eastern District of California, Sacramento; Lilian Tsang, Chapter 13 trustee, Modesto; Teri Wegemer, paralegal for Chapter 13 trustee David Cusick, Sacramento; Walter Dahl, attorney and Subchapter V trustee, Granite Bay; Mark Zimmerman, attorney, Hanford; Eddy Emmons, Clerk of the Court, Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District

of California, San Francisco; Loris Bakken, Chapter 7 trustee, Lodi; and Pauldeep Bains, attorney, Roseville.

For each applicant selected for an interview by the collective bankruptcy court bench, the committee shall: (1) conduct an interview to ascertain his/her qualifications, as well as to assess his/her relative strengths vis-à-vis each other applicant for the position; and (2) reduce its findings to writing and submit them to the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court.
